I like your story because it was so lovely and colorful.

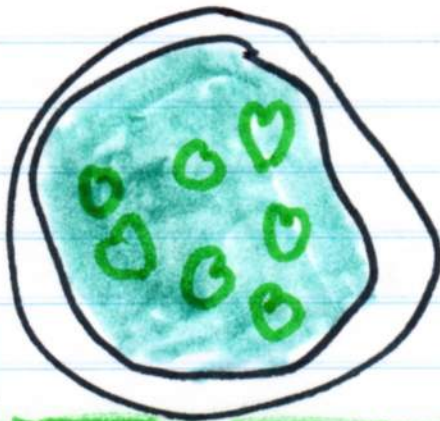

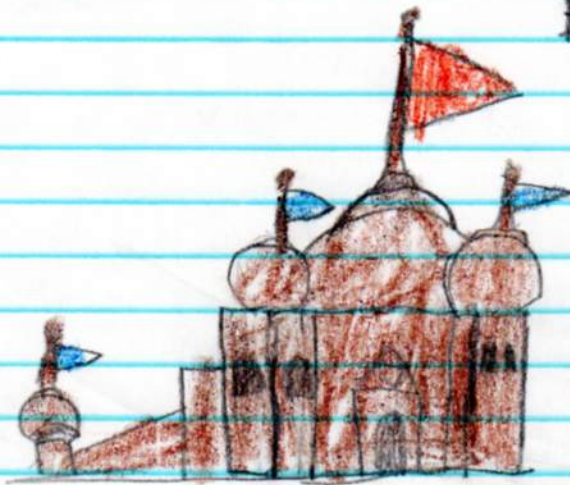

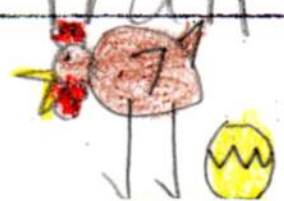
